Subject: Having Sight, But No Vision

Proverbs 4:20-21 My son, be attentive to my words; incline your ear to my sayings. Let them not escape from your sight; keep them within your heart.

Do you have any personal core values?

Core Values are:

- > Words that you deeply believe.
- > Ideals that explain what you live by.
- Guidelines for what you want to ultimately accomplish.
- Stronger than thoughts or opinions because they move you to action.
- > The inner-based principles that fuel your choices.
- Qualities, which represent your highest priorities.

Setting off on the path of wisdom is no casual thing. Paying careful attention to words of wisdom is required, if those words are going to give you "sight". Lacking direction/vision (not having any core values) is the equivalent of being blind because you ultimately don't know where you're going. Similarly, having the ability to physically see, but not having any vision for your life is worse than being physically blind and having vision.
