Our bodies follow our eyes. What we look at will eventually become our focus. The eyes are one of the most powerful entryways into our minds. If you can decide what your eyes will look at then you will have already won half the battle.

“Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God”. Hebrews 12:2

Jesus was able to do the Triumphant Entry because He kept His eyes on His Father. Keeping your focus on God will empower you, to not only overcome the hard things but, to do the impossible. Peter walked on water while his friends stayed in the boat terrified, because he had a different focus. The fastest way to lose your vision is to focus on things that change. Keeping your eyes on those things that never change help you chart your course of action in the most stable way.

P2R (Point 2 Remember): *Make your decision on what you will focus on before, so that situations you run into won't decide your focus for you.*
