## Will You Do All the Will of God & Will You Serve the Purpose of God in Your Generation?

**Acts 13:21-22**} Then they asked for a king, and God gave them Saul the son of Kish, a man of the tribe of Benjamin, for forty years. And when he had removed him, he raised up David to be their king, of whom he testified and said, 'I have found in David the son of Jesse **a man after my heart, who will do all my will.'** 

**1 Sam 13} King Saul sins** – does not take responsibility – justifies and makes excuses -> loses Kingdom and Crown

**2 Samuel} David is crowned King** – King David sins (Adultery & Murder) 2 Samuel 12} David takes responsibility "I have sinned" ... David is forgiven and keeps the Kingdom – but great consequences: "the sword will never depart from your house ... son shall die"

When you sin, how do you respond? ... Justify & Excuses or Confession & "I have sinned"

Acts 13:36 } "For David, after he had served the purpose of God in his own generation ..." God makes no more mention of David's sin

<u>P2R (Point 2 Remember)</u> We all sin – those who repent and confess, are not only forgiven ... if they get back up – they can do All the Will of God & Serve the Purpose of God in Your Own Generation.

\_"[*The Genealogy of Jesus Christ*] The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the **son of David** ..." When God chooses to send His Salvation, the Messiah, the Son of God ... He is called Jesus, son of David!
